## *Cellar Reserve* **FINE OLD TAWNY**

### The Wine

A complex, elegant fortified wine with lifted rancio, toffee and vanillin notes. The palate is sweet and mellow with hints of nutmeg and toast. An excellent style with balance and length.

### The Grapes

The majority of fruit in this blend is Grenache. Grenache is well suited to the hot climate of the Murray Darling and its characteristic vibrant fruit and low tannin produce great aged tawny. Each year the fruit is picked late in the season once the berries are very sweet and full of flavour.

### The Winemaking

The grapes were crushed and fermented on skins until the desired sugar level was reached. The ferment was then stopped by adding neutral spirit and pressed into small oak vats and left to age. This tawny is a blend of many vintages dating back to 1990 and its average age is 19 years old.

### With Food

Try chilled as an aperitif or with hard nutty cheese or baked figs; also great with orange tart.
